A new imaging device (MelaFind®) from Mela Sciences (<a href="www.melasciences.com">www.melasciences.com</a>) was recently approved by the FDA for the detection of melanoma skin cancer. If the computer determines that cancer may be present, a biopsy can be taken. The new device has proven to be highly accurate and may prevent unneeded biopsies.
